3. BMW Gap Analysis

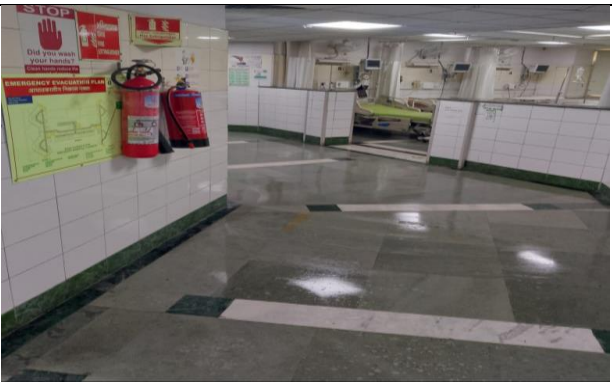
