1. **Biomedical Waste Management (BMWM)**
 - o Review of current BMW segregation practices in line with BMW Rules, 2016 (amended 2018 & 2019).

 - o Minor non-compliances noted in certain wards regarding labeling of waste bins and timely waste transfer. Action point – Labeling will be completed in all patient care areas

 - o Engineering and housekeeping teams reported progress in maintaining dust-free zones, particularly in ICU and OT.
 - o Swachhata Drive activities highlighted improved floor maintenance and periodic deep cleaning.
3. **Hand Hygiene & Patient Safety**
 - o Swachhata Drive observed increased sanitizer station use and compliance in high-risk areas.
 - o Action Point: Monthly compliance scorecards to be displayed in all clinical areas.

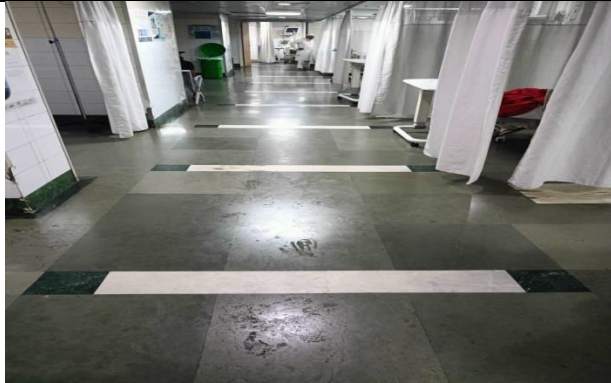
